Scrolling

There are many different ways of scrolling (i.e. moving up and down the page). Some are much faster than others, but it's entirely up to you which one you use. The scroll bar is on the right-hand side of the window, and it usually has arrows at top and bottom, and a 'scroll box' in between. The position of the scroll box shows you how far through the entire document you are, and the *size* of it shows you how long the document is. The smaller the scroll box, the bigger the document. (See examples.)

Scrolling methods, roughly in order of speed:

1. Use scroll wheel on mouse
2. Use arrow keys on keyboard
3. Click repeatedly on arrows at ends of scroll bar
4. Click and HOLD on arrows at ends of scroll bar
5. Click on scroll bar BETWEEN arrows and scroll box - this moves up or down a whole page at a time
6. (on web only) Press space bar on keyboard - this moves down a whole page at a time (shift-space moves up)
7. Click and drag scroll box up or down - this is the fastest way of moving all the way to the top or bottom (some keyboards have keys that take you straight to the top or bottom, but not all keyboards do)
